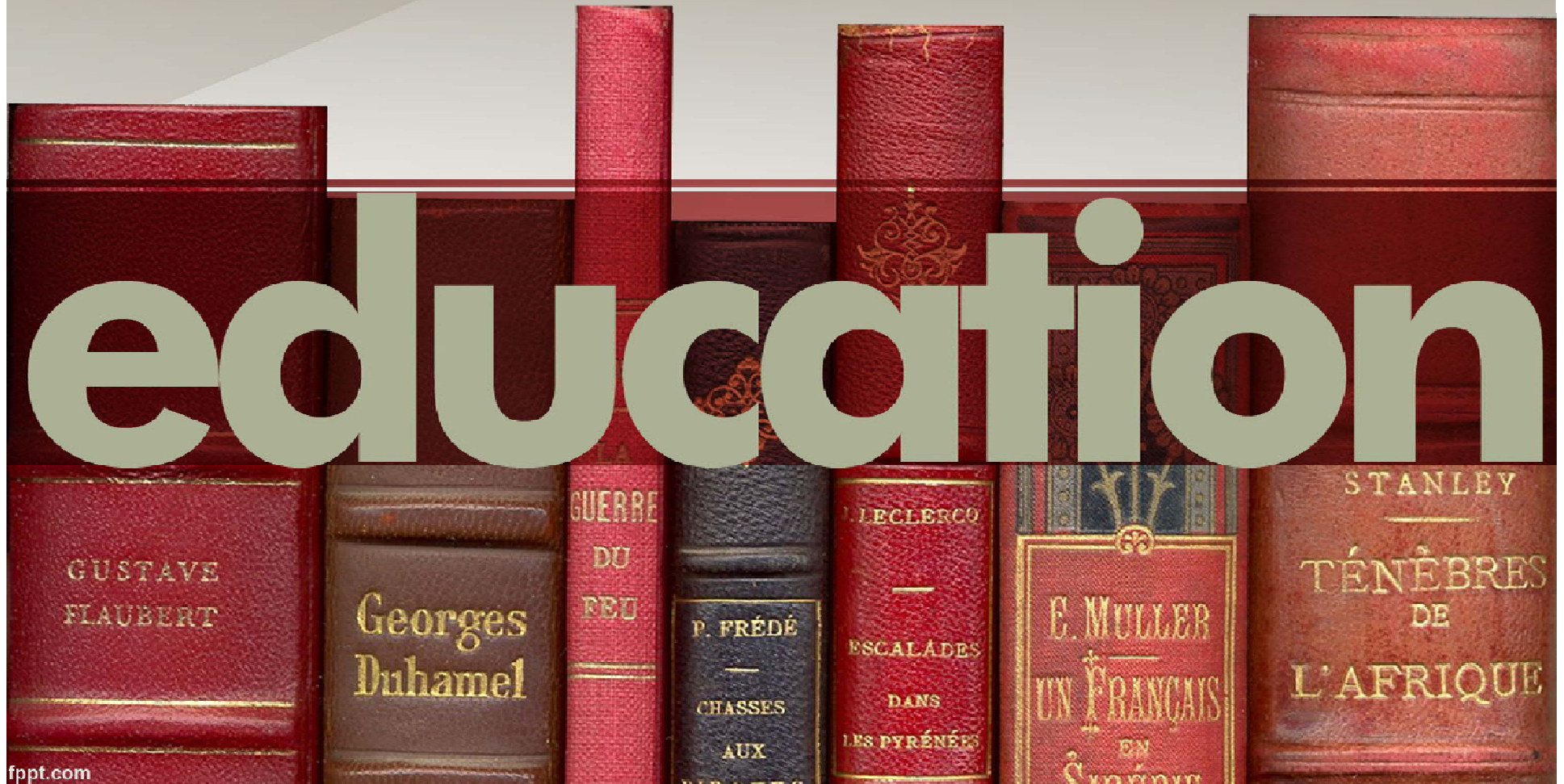

Introduction-about Porto

Porto is the second-largest city in Portugal

- Located along the Douro river estuary in Northern Portugal
- Porto is one of the oldest European centres
- Porto is the city with long tradition in education and some customs are kept up to the present day



Polytechnic Institute of Porto- IPP

Porto Polytechnic was established in Porto in 1985 and its objective was to re-launch the polytechnic studies in Portugal.

Today, it is the largest polytechnic institute of Portugal, with seven schools and 16 000 students.

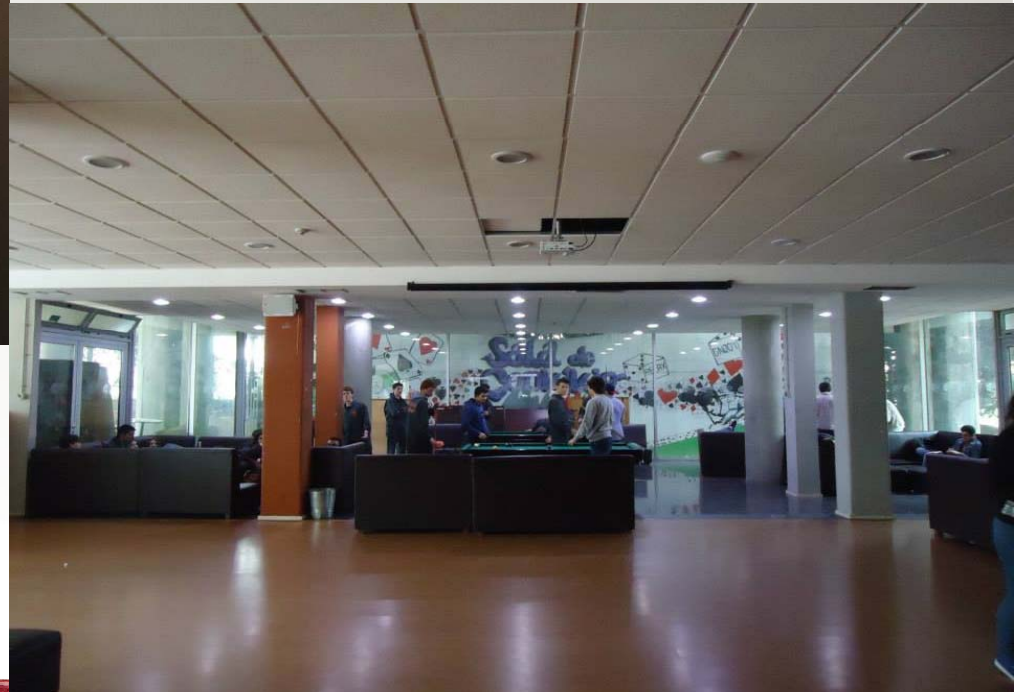


- is an independent organization
