Twelfth meeting of the ECBAC Tempus project consortium was held on 25th and 26th February 2015 in Cuprija at the High Medical School of Professional Studies. The participants agreed upon the final steps in the realization of the ECBAC project. Also, the first student fair dedicated to the medical field was held during the first day of the meeting. In the last week of March, two student visits within the ECABC 517200 were carried out being immediately followed by a consortium meeting which was attended by 12 representatives of the consortium members and 11 students from each partner HEI from Serbia.



In Gent, the students heard more about the student role in the student life and management of institutions and the way of functioning of the student services. On the third day of the visit to Gent, VLHORA was the host of the meeting. At the same time, eleven students visited Allen with the same aims. The visit to Porto was realized in the period from 5th to 10th April. The student visits have shown a new insight in the teaching methods. Advisory monitoring visit to 517200-2011

Advisory monitoring visit to 517200-2011 took place in Belgrade, April 7th 2015. The host of the event was the Railway College of professional studies. The representatives of the Erasmus NTO, Maria Filipovic and Nina Stojanovic had a two hour long conversation with all the relevant representatives of the Serbian consortium members from the HE area, discussing all the aspects of the activities performed so far and the final steps on the project.

The purpose of the visit was to learn about the realised activities and the products developed so far, as well as to check whether the project team has encountered any problems in operational and/or financial implementation that could be discussed and solved.
