# Legal Framework

- Participation Decree of 2004
  - Rights:
    - Working without fear of retribution
    - Being representative of the whole student population
    - Right to co-decide on the following subjects:
      - Tuition fees
      - Education and exam regulation
      - The execution of all student-related policies
      - Rules concerning international student mobility
      - Determining the academic calendar
    - Right to advice on the following subjects:
      - Internal quality assurance
    - Students are represented in all decision taking organs of the institution
    - Logistical, financial and/or administrative support
  - Duties:
    - Annual elections, in which 10% of the students cast their vote
    - Minimum of 4 assemblies a year
    - Strategic plan of action

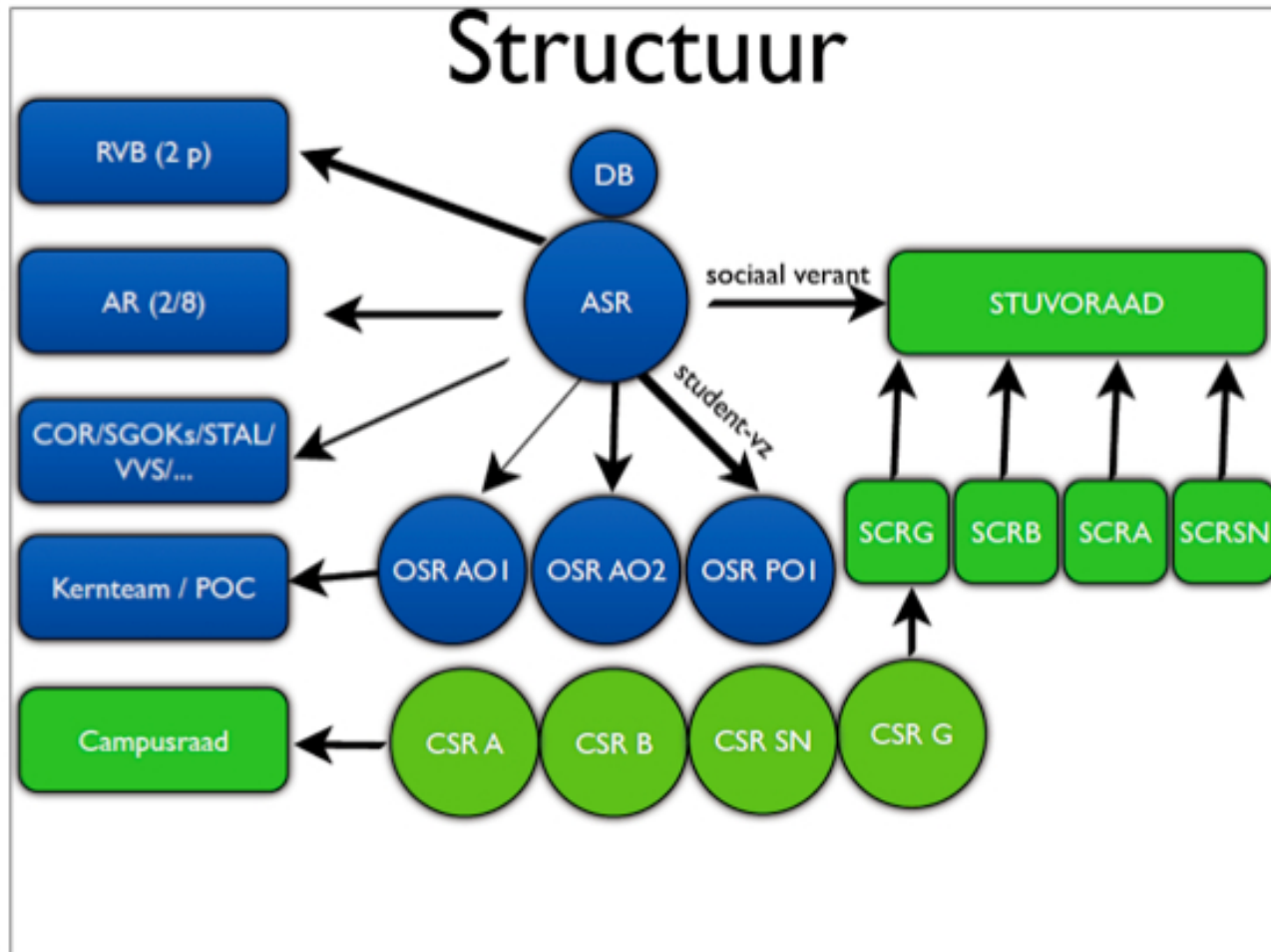


# Algemene Studentenraad HUB-KAHO

- Representing of the 15000 students of the HUB-KAHO within the institution, VVS and StAL
- Directly elected General Assembly in May
- Representing every program
- 47 Members
- 1 member per 700 students



# Structures of the ASR HUB-KAHO

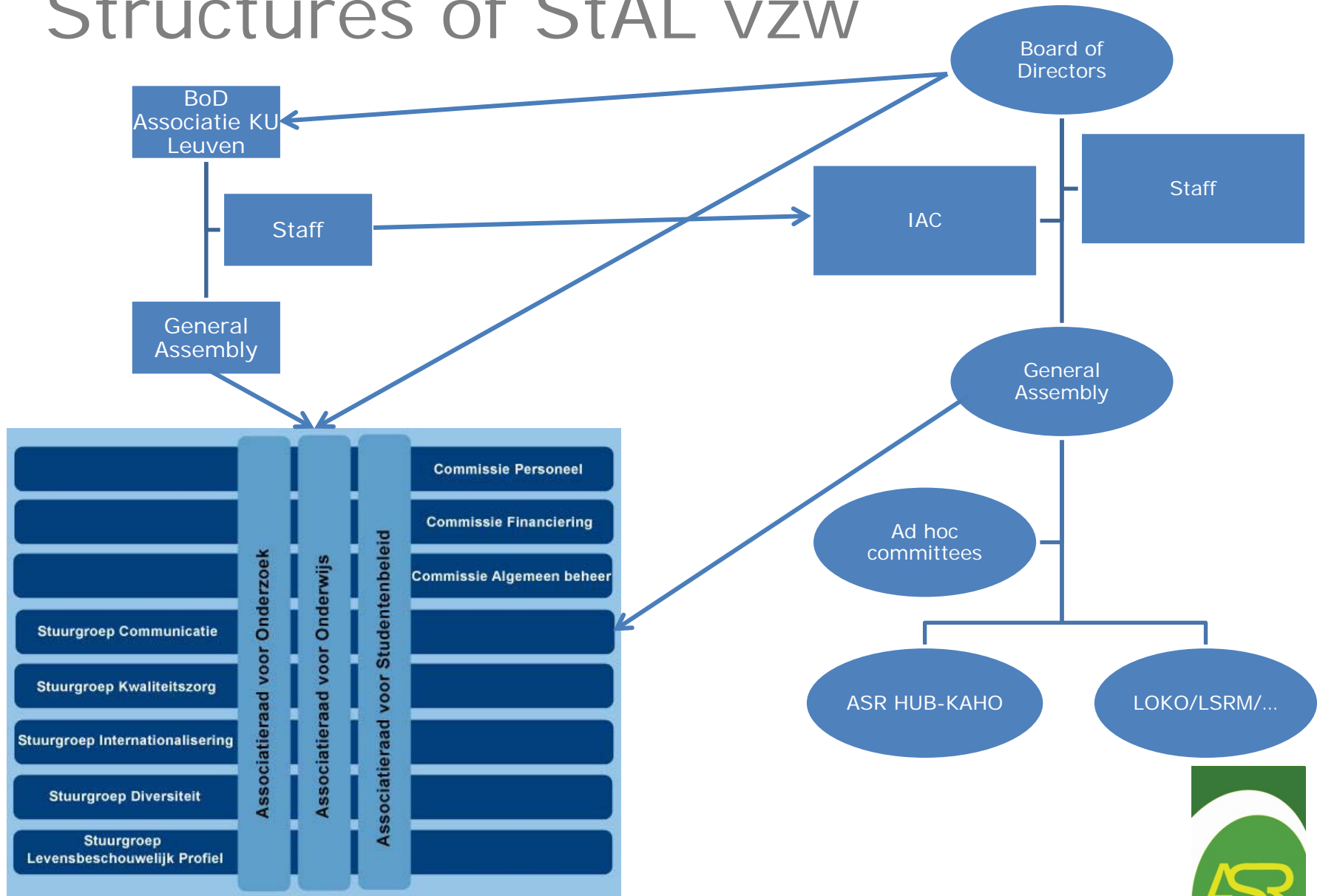


# Studentenraad Associatie Leuven

- Representing 80000 students within the Associatie KU Leuven
- 11 members
- 1 vote per 10000 students in the institution
- ASR has 3 votes (out of 17)



# Structures of StAL vzw

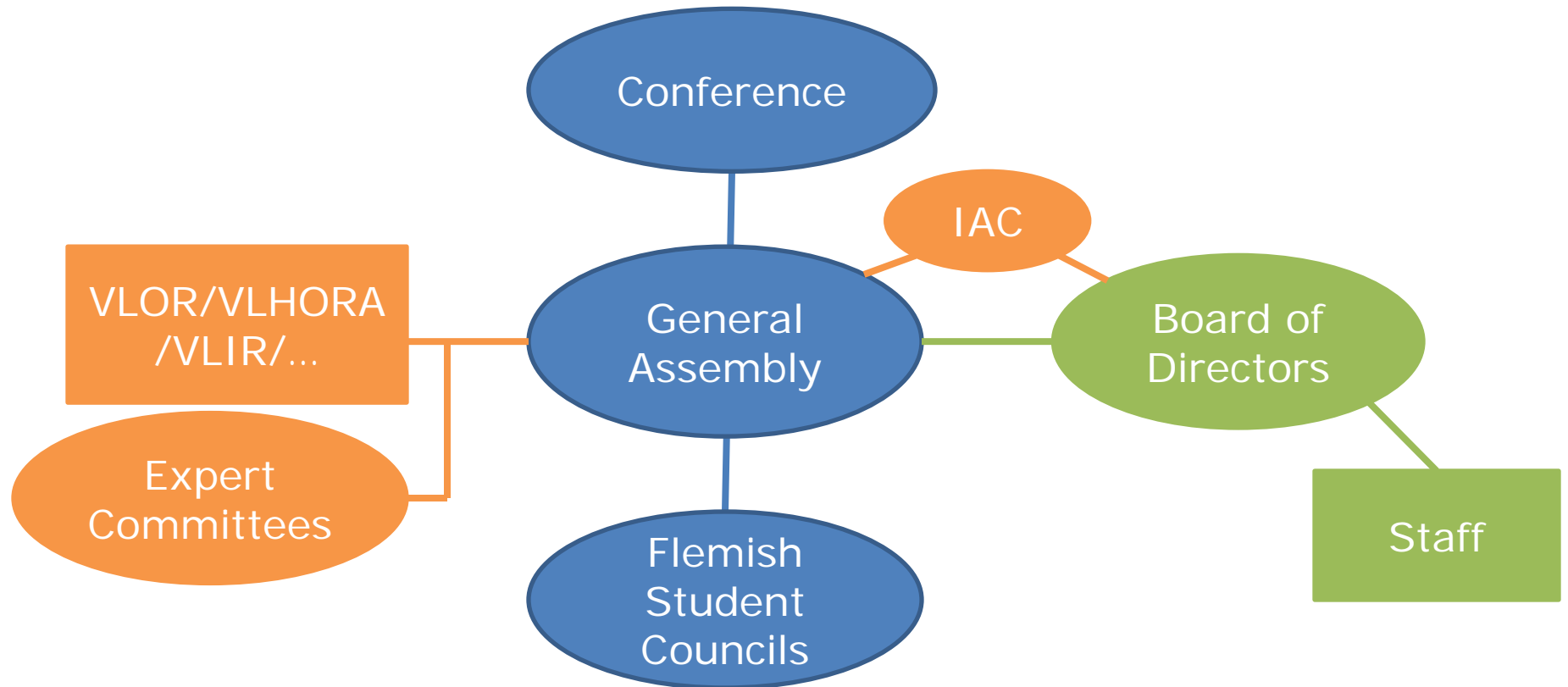


# Vlaamse Vereniging van Studenten

- Representing all university and college students in Flanders within the national participation structures and the ESU.
- 28 members
- Votes according to D'Hondt method
- ASR has 5 votes (out of 50)
